### **Some Scriptural Observations:**

#### In the *Old Testament*

(Isaiah 41:1-4; 44:6-7; 48:12-13; Psalm 90:1-2)

- "First and last" is a reference to G o d Himself
- Describes God's *all-encompassing nature* that in His being lies the <u>totality</u> of all <u>existence</u>.

#### In the New Testament (Revelation 1:8, 17-18; 21:1-6; 22:12-13)

- "Alpha and Omega" is a reference to G o d Himself (1:8; 21:6)
- Jesus is <u>a s s e r t i n q</u> that He is <u>G o d</u> (1:17-18; 22:12-13)
- Jesus is the <u>s o u r c e</u> of life and the <u>f i n a l</u> goal toward which <u>a l l</u> of life is moving

## This truth of the <u>p r e s e n c e</u> of the *Alpha and Omega* means that I:

- am <u>n o t</u> an <u>a c c i d e n t</u> (Jeremiah 1:4-5; Psalm 139:13-18)
- have an ultimate <u>purpose</u> in my <u>existence</u> (Acts 17:26-27; Ephesians 2:10)
- am not a <u>victim</u> of my <u>circum stances</u> or <u>surroundings</u> (Romans 11:36; 2 Corinthians 11:21b-31; 12:9-10)
- have <u>significance</u> to <u>God</u>
   (Hebrews 6:10; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Matthew 28:20)
