Remember To S e r v e God and Others (Mark 14:12-16)

- It requires my w i l l i n g n e s s and a v a i l a b i l i t y.
(v 12)
- It may require me to s t a n d out. (v 13)
- It may require me to take a r i s k. (v 14)
- It always requires me to a c t. (vs 13-15)

Remember to Truthfully E x a m i n e Myself

(Mark 14:17-21; Ps 41:9)

- I may be able to fool o t h e r s, but I cannot fool G o d.
(v 18)
- We are all capable of betraying or d e s e r t i n g the truth.
(v 19)
- Rejection of Jesus carries s e r i o u s consequences. (v 21)

Remember the C o s t of My Forgiveness

(Mark 14:22-25; 1 Cor 11:23-26)

- The cost of my salvation required the s u f f e r i n g and d e a t h of Jesus. (vs 22-24)
- I am to remember that I am part of His f e l l o w s h i p.
(vs 22-24)
- I can be certain of my f u t u r e because of His promise.
(v 25)
