**What Job teaches us about G o d...**

- God is in control of e v e r y t h i n g (1:6, 10-12; 2:1, 4-6; 41:11)
- There is n o t h i n g that God c a n n o t do (42:2)
- It is impossible to f r u s t r a t e God's p u r p o s e s (42:2)
- God's w a y s are b e y o n d our understanding and explanation (42:3)
- God is always j u s t and f a i r (42:7-10)

**What Job teaches us about o u r s e l v e s...**

- I can t r u s t God even when explanations are m i s s i n g (1:20-22)
- I need to t h i n k before I r e s p o n d to a friend who is suffering (2:11-13)
- Right t h e o l o g y keeps me s t a b l e in the storm (2:4-10)
- Seeing God as He really i s brings h u m i l i t y and a c c e p t a n c e of His will (42:4-6)
- Obedient e n d u r a n c e leads to growth and m a t u r i t y (James 1:2-4, 5:10-11)

**The *greatest lesson* from the book of Job is:**

It's not knowing the a n s w e r s to all the questions, but it's knowing G o d that makes all the d i f f e r e n c e in life.
