- b e a r burdens appropriately (vs 2-5)

• **generously s h a r i n g my blessings (6:6-10)**

Those who b e n e f i t from s p i r i t u a l instruction are to s u p p l y the m a t e r i a l needs of those who teach (v 6; 1 Cor 9:9-14; 1 Tim 5:17-18)

I ought to understand the p r i n c i p l e s of the “L a w o f t h e H a r v e s t”:

- i n v e s t m e n t - I will reap only I F I plant (v 7; Prov 20:4; 24:30-34)
- i d e n t i t y - I will harvest only W H A T I plant (v 8; Prov 11:18; Job 4:8)
- t i m e - I will harvest only A F T E R I plant (v 9; Psalm 126:5-6)
- m u l t i p l i c a t i o n - I will harvest M O R E than I plant (v 9-10; 2 Cor 9:6; James 5:7-8)

• **focusing on the right things (6:11-18)**

- I am not to focus on the o u t w a r d works of s e l f-effort but on the i n w a r d work of the C r o s s of Christ (vs 12-15)
