We have an idolatry problem (Exodus 20:1-6; 1 John 5:21)

An *idol* is something we love and pursue instead of God
(Romans 1:21-23; 2 Kings 14:14-15; 17:40-41)

Idolatry is what we do when we are not fully satisfied in
God (Ezekiel 14:2-6; Colossians 3:5)

Mark 10:17-22; Matthew 6:19-24

The BIG idea: Whatever comes between you and God,
you need to get rid of it!

How do I root out these idols in my life?

- Read the Bible (Hebrews 4:12; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)
- Allow the Holy Spirit to teach and reveal
(John 14:25; 16:13-15; Psalm 139:23-24)
- Be engaged with others in the local church
(Galatians 6:1-4; Romans 15:14; 2 Timothy 4:2)

Three Questions:

Is Jesus my treasure?

Do I *really believe* that Jesus is worth abandoning
everything for?

What is it that keeps me from having that kind of passion
for Jesus? Or to put it another way, what would I rather
have than Jesus? _____
