Being faithful to the finish means remembering that...

We may face a new problem, but we have the same God (11:1-5)

- Even when we have victory, the enemy will not stop (vs 1-3)
- Our challenges are usually always bigger than our solutions (vs 4-5; 1 Sam 17:4-11)

We aren't to rely on past strategies, but seek God's plan for each challenge (11:6-15)

- With every new problem we should listen for God's wisdom (v 6; Jas 1:5-7)
- With God we are to be proactive and not reactive (vs 7-13; Phil 1:12-18)
- We are to do all that God commands (vs 14-15)

When we obey God, we realize God's rest (11:16-23)

- Obedience is demonstrated over time (vs 16-20)
 - 1) Obedience is progressive (vs 16-19; Gal 6:9)
 - 2) Obedience confirms God's purposes (vs 20; 2 Cor 9:13)
- God's rest is available to those who obey His word (vs 21-23; Heb 3-4)

Our obedience over time is a testimony to God's faithfulness (12:1-24)

- When we are "faithful to the finish", we are able to reflect on God's faithfulness to accomplish great things through us.
